Wean to Harvest Biosecurity Gaps

Increasing research evidence is revealing gaps in wean-to-harvest biosecurity. The Swine Health Information Centre (SHIC) <u>Swine Disease Monitoring Report</u> aggregate data shows breeding herd breaks of PRRS and PED tend to follow breaks in wean-to-harvest sites.


Passport GPS


